3. If you were to sit with God and ask why He came up with marriage, how would He answer?

5. Jesus made a wedding vow before the Father. How does this perspective impact your own walk with Jesus?
6. The Bible teaches a counter cultural approach to submitting to one another. Discuss.
7. Why do we bristle at the idea of submitting to one another?
8. How does the concept of "Lead Servant" change our perception of being the head?
9. How does the interaction between husband and wife in marriage mirror the gospel?
10. Discuss what it means to be Jesus to your spouse.
