Food for Thought for the week of October 1, 2017

(Questions and Scriptures for further study and discussion.)

1. In the Old Testament, the term "Son of Man" always referred to man. Why do you think Jesus then referred to himself as the "Son of Man?"
2. Discuss how the "suffering Jesus" is the opposite of our concept of God.
3. What about how Jesus came to earth and His suffering might have caused men to reject Him as God? How does this correlate to our world today?
4. Think about what people value in our society. How can we expect our message to touch people today?
5. What lies does Satan use to make people believe they don't need a savior? How do we contribute to these lies?
6. Think back to the beginning in the garden, why was Satan even in the garden? What does that tell us about God's view of mankind?
7. In verse 6, the writer quotes Psalm 8, asking, "what is man that you are mindful of him?" What does that tell us about God? What does that reveal to us about God's view of our role in His grand plan?
8. Take a look at Psalm 22. Besides the fact that this was written years before Jesus, what astounding things can we see from this psalm? What hope do we derive from these words?
9. Discuss your feelings about the fact that we will rule over angels in the world to come?
