Food for Thought for the week of June 4, 2017

(Questions and Scriptures for further study and discussion.)

1. Discuss habits we know are hard on relationships. Think about the time we spend glued to our phones or tvs versus the time we spend talking to or investing in those we care about. When was the last time you wrote a handwritten letter or taught your kids how to do something with their hands such as changing a tire, cooking a meal, etc. Is the world dictating our behavior?
2. Discuss the effect social media has on relationships with friends and family. Does it help or hurt? Does it actually make people lonely?
3. Has our generation become numb to watching or hearing about people die? Why?
4. Is it possible to really see people as "needing Jesus" instead of only seeing them for their sins and struggles?
5. What is Christian love? How can we demonstrate it this week in our circle of influence?
6. Talk about what it means to be "tenderhearted". Is this the key that will motivate us to love people we don't know?
