2. In Hebrews 2:1, what is the author calling us not to drift from?
3. What does the Gospel mean for you? When did you first find Jesus?
4. How is Jesus God's final word?
5. What are some distractions that call our focus off of the good news of Jesus?
6. What happens when these things overcome our focus on the Gospel message and we forget the good news? Why is it important to remember?
7. How can we practically "pay much closer attention" to the Gospel? Who, in your life, can you pray for that is drifting away from Jesus?
