4. Are there "dead" areas in your life, areas that seem hopeless? In the lives of your family members, coworkers?
5. Has God ever asked you to do something that seemed like unreasonable obedience?
6. How do you think God wants us to respond to these hopeless and dead areas?
7. What does God do that makes them know that He is the Lord? vs 6

What does this mean today? Read Acts 2
