

**ASK:** Please Show Me Your Glory

Text: Exodus 33:18-34:9

Glory is what comes from the sum total of a person.

It's our instinct to share what moves us, and we tend to give glory to what moves us.

There is rest when we cease trying to be what we are not, and cease trying to do what we cannot.

### **ASK #3 - PLEASE SHOW ME YOUR GLORY.**

When we see God's glory we become aware of our sinfulness.

TENSION OF SEEING GOD'S GLORY - Shout for joy because of His grace, and fall face down in reverential fear.

**Question:** *Are we having experiences of God or experiences with ourselves?*

Every glimpse of God is grace.

God is willing to share His glory with us, but it's on His terms and not ours.

GOD'S TERMS::

1. We must be ready. We must be available.
2. Come up
3. Present yourself.

He ultimately paid the price SO THAT we may be able to ask to see His glory.

John 1:14-16; Hebrews 1:1-3; 2:1; Acts 26:13-15; 1 Timothy 6:16; Romans 12:1-2; 2 Corinthians 3:17-18; Psalm 24:3-6

**Food for Thought for the week of December 11, 2016**

Text: Exodus 33:18-34:9

1. Why is it so important to see the glory of God? Read 2 Corinthians 10:3-5.
2. Glory is "the sum total of a person; sum worth and power of a person". Read Isaiah 40:18-28.  
How do you measure the glory of God?  
What competes most for His spot in your heart?
3. Read Exodus 33:17-34:7. When Moses asked God to show him His glory what attributes did God highlight [34:6-7]? Why those and not others?
4. What would you say are God's two most important attributes? Why?
5. Read Paul's account of God revealing His glory to him in Acts 26:13-18.  
How did (does) God reveal His glory to you?
6. Read Ephesians 1:15-21. Paul prayed the church in Ephesus would see God's glory. Spend some time praying for family, friends and our church to see the glory of God.
