Food for Thought for the week of March 20, 2016

(Questions and Scriptures for further study and discussion.)

Text: Isaiah 52:13-15, 53:1-12

1. Before reading the passage together, pray that God would show Himself through His word.
2. This passage can seem familiar to a lot of Christians, but was there anything new God revealed to you this time? What stood out to you if you've never read the passage before?
3. How did this week's message impact you? What challenged you? What questions did it raise? What confused you?
4. How has following Jesus not been what you expected? How has God not been what you expected?
5. What personally draws you to Jesus? When you think of your loved ones, who don't know Jesus, what are you hoping draws them to Jesus?
6. What do you think when you hear "(insert your name), die to yourself"? What are the areas in your life that need to be put to death?
7. Who are the people in your life God is calling you to be a "suffering servant" for? What does He want you to do?

Application:

How is God personally calling you to respond to this message? Is it to worship? To repent? To have patience? To pray?
