Text: Exodus 33:1-17

God invites us to pray; so we pray to invite Him in.

ASK #1 – God teach me Your ways.

He was able to make the ask on the basis of his relationship with God.

Your view of God will determine everything else about you.

Even though we may think we know everything, we simply don't and we're not even close.

God teaches us who He is by being WITH us.

Rest can only be found by placing our faith in who God is.
In order to know who God is, we must be aware of God's presence.

God's presence means that God's involved.

ASK #2 – Be present in my life.

Our Father in Heaven will always give His very best.

Ask for these things and put yourself in a position to encounter it.

Text: Exodus 33-34

1. When you were a child, what were some things you asked for and really wanted for Christmas? Did you ever get those presents?

If you are a parent, what is it like when your kids ask you for presents?

2. What do you usually ask God for?

Are there things that you want to ask God for, but are too afraid to ask?

3. How does our relationship with God determine how we pray?

Do you notice how your belief in God effects how you pray?

4. Why is God's presence so important?

5. In his message, Pastor Brandon said, “God is only limited by our availability to Him.” What can we do to make ourselves more accessible to Him?

6. When going about your day, how often do you acknowledge God?

What typically gets in the way?

How can we make this practice more natural?

7. God is with us RIGHT NOW! What are the signs that we are living in His presence?

What if we lived this truth out every day?
