WAYS TO GIVE AT PLEASANT VALLEY:

Cash or Check: Place your check or cash in a secure giving box during any Sunday service. Contributions may also be sent to the PV office.

Automatic Giving: Fill out a green form from the brochure kiosk to consistently give weekly/monthly via checking or savings account. This is the most cost-effective method of automatic giving for the church.



Online Giving: Scan this QR code or visit pvwinona.com to set up an online account to give one-time or consistent weekly/monthly via credit card*, debit card, checking or savings account.

Text Giving: With your smartphone or device, text a dollar amount to 507.697.1988. You'll receive a text with a link. Tap the link, enter your information, and the credit* or debit card you'd like to use for all future gifts. Next time you're ready to give, text the dollar amount to the number above. (To give to Irresistible, include the code "II") Example: text "\$50 II" if you want to give \$50 to Irresistible.

In April of 2014, the PV family was invited to partner in an initiative called Irresistible. The goal remains the same: to connect more people to Jesus and align

more Christ followers to His purpose.

We set out to accomplish three things that would require sacrifice, commitment, and financial resources: eliminate the \$1,000,000 debt, re-purpose the facility, and bless local ministries.

\$4,338,411 of the \$3.6 million goal has been pledged!

We have already accomplished much. In Phase 1, we installed a new Audio/Video/Lighting system in the Ministry Center.

In Phase 2, the long-standing debt was eliminated. Local ministries have been financially blessed.

Phase 3 Building Plans are in process. Copies are available on the brochure kiosk and at pvwinona.com/irresistible.

Policy Change - Thank you for your generosity to the Lord's work at Pleasant Valley Church. As you may know, the 2016-17 budget reflected a policy change. Since Benevolence and Missions are such a high priority, we are now including support for them in the General Budget. This means Benevolence and Missions expenditures are no longer dependent upon designated giving. Therefore, please continue to support benevolence and missions through generosity to the general fund. Beginning with gifts received after April 1, 2016, all gifts designated to Missions and or Benevolence will be directed to the general fund.

Please do continue to support any particular intern and or the Irresistible Initiative by specific designation.

The Missions and Benevolence policy change allows Pleasant Valley Church:

1. To increase expenditures on Missions and Benevolence, when desired, without depending on designated giving.
2. To increase flexibility regarding the use of funds, so funds can be targeted to needs as the Spirit leads.
3. To fully comply with IRS regulations: if a person wants to give a contribution to a church and get a tax deduction, the donor must relinquish control and allow the church to use the contribution however the church best decides. (Designated gifts prior to April 1, 2016 will still be tax deductible.)
