Pleasant Valley Church is pursuing an initiative that will do three things that require sacrifice, commitment and financial resources: **Repurpose the facility** (classroom remodeling, audio-visual-lighting (AVL) needs,

and traffic flow), **Retire existing debt**, and **Bless local ministries**.

A Re-Purposing Update from the Building Design Team (Lonna Benson, Kris Blanchard, Chad Ellenburg, Michael Isakson, Paul Omdal, David Rosenua, Carina Semling, Dean Wendler, and Brandon Zieske):

"We have been meeting over the last few months reviewing where to start based on: 1. Recommendations and cost estimates provided by the Clark Group. 2. What the team believed were the greatest needs.

The decision was made to start with an overhaul of the AVL for the Ministry Center. In recent years, things have been declining to the point where trying to "fix" the things that needed fixing was cost prohibitive. The AVL team has done a tremendous job of trying to make the issues invisible to us. Starting Monday, December 8th, a group from Clark will be here to install a sound system, speakers, projector and stage lights. We are very excited about this and believe it will greatly enhance everyone's worship experience and make managing lights and sound much easier.

Our next step is to select an architect. We are currently in the search process and hope to have an architect selected in the first quarter of 2015. We will provide updates monthly to keep you informed about the re-purposing. We ask for your prayers for the AVL install -- safe travels for the Clark team and a smooth implementation of all equipment and systems.

Thank you for your prayers and encouragement. We are excited about what God is doing at Pleasant Valley and can't wait to see what is next!"
